STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

This Intergroup Service was formed by the AA groups within Osceola County for the express purpose of establishing an Osceola County Office through which the groups, their members and the general public could be served more effectively than could be done by the groups individually.

The services that Intergroup supplies include:

- Assigning “Twelve Step” calls on a geographical basis.
- Maintaining a supply of approved books and literature.
- Maintaining AA listings in telephone directories.
- Publishing a directory of local AA meetings (printable meeting guide and meeting guide app, accessible on an Android or Apple mobile app)
- Serving as a communication center for local groups, keeping them informed about AA activities by website, calendar of events, email, and/or when available, newsletters.
- Handling requests for information about AA from the general public
- Furnishing speakers for AA groups and for non-AA organizations.
- Sponsoring and arranging any joint social affairs which the members may desire.

These activities are supported by voluntary contributions of groups within Intergroup area. An accounting of the funds received is made at each monthly meeting.

Every AA group in Osceola County is automatically a member of this Intergroup; entitled to representation and vote at each Intergroup Meeting.

Any AA member is welcome as a guest at all Intergroup Meetings.
